When this happens **mail is held back at the post office until the correct postage is paid by this office the recipient.**

Can we all please try to remember the correct postage rates:

Small DLE envelopes are 50 cents

A5 envelopes (half the size of an A4) are \$1.00

A4 sized envelopes (larger size that fits an A4 piece of paper) are \$1.50

Larger envelopes are \$2.00 depending on the thickness

Envelopes posted in any of the above sizes that are extra thick will incur an extra cost.

## **The 2009 International Conference on Aging and Spirituality**

- **August 30 to September 2, Auckland, New Zealand.**
- ***Gender, Culture, and Care***
- **Hosted by the Selwyn Centre for Aging and Spirituality**

This is the first time a Conference dedicated to issues related to Aging and Spirituality will be held in New Zealand. The Selwyn Foundation, New Zealand's largest charitable trust dedicated to aged care service delivery, has established a new Unit, The Selwyn Centre for Aging and Spirituality (SCAS). It is SCAS which will be hosting the 2009 Conference as part of its key objective, to be New Zealand's voice for the spiritual needs of older people as they near their life's end.

SCAS has been set up to lead education, research, and advocacy, in any areas of need related to aging and spirituality in New Zealand, working closely with other similar organisations in Australia, the UK and the USA. The focus of the 2009 Conference is on *gender, culture, and models of care*, that will, through the presenters and discussions, enhance the conference attendees' understanding of transformational spiritual care, that goes beyond the traditional medical model.
